

# Applying Photo Filters for Improved Cast

1. Select and open a portrait that could be improved by adjusting skin tones.

2. Open the layers panel. If it is not open, choose Window>Layers or press F7.

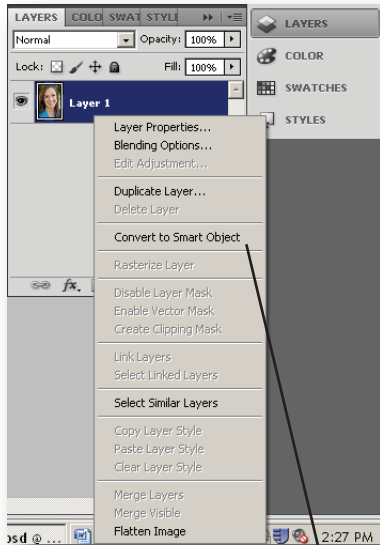
3. Right click on the layer and choose "Convert to Smart Object." This creates an easily changeable effect to a photo.

4. Now click on the black and white circle icon at the bottom of the layers panel and then choose "Photo Filter."

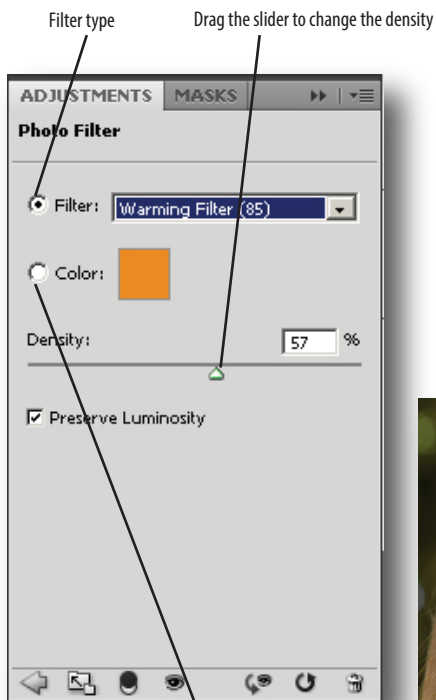
5. Choose a filter type, or color, which ever will work best. Dragging the density slider will add more or less of the color to the photo. Adjust these controls as necessary.

6. Using the eraser, erase areas that should not have the cast added (usually teeth, eyes, etc.).

7. At any point, this layer can be deleted, leaving the original image untouched.

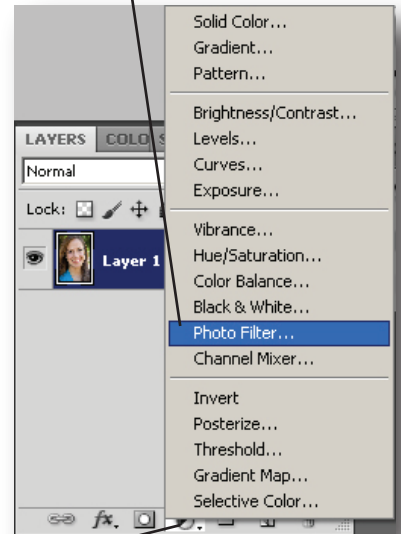


Right click on Layer, Choose Convert to Smart Object
