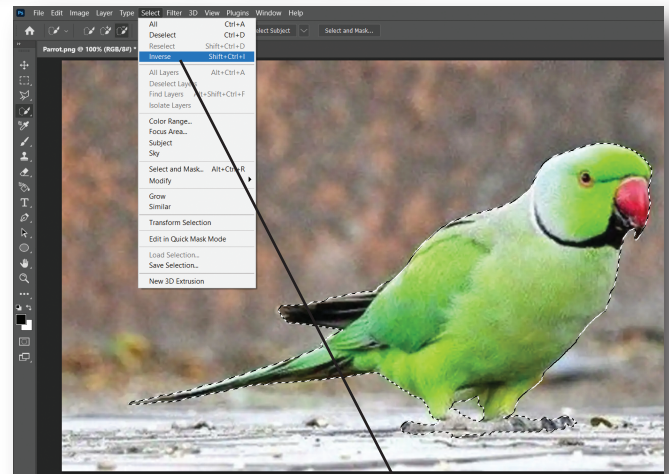


# Turning a Selection into a Cutout

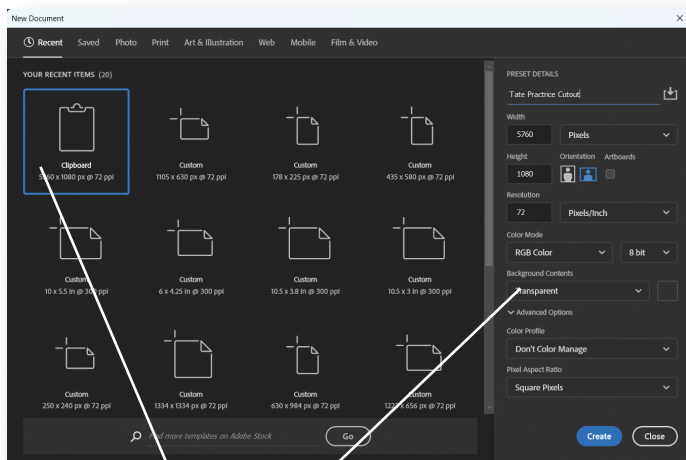
1. Make sure the correct part of the image is selected. If the background is selected instead of the image, choose Select>Inverse to swap the selected area.
2. Copy the image by pressing Ctrl X or going to Edit>Cut.



Press Ctrl X to Cut the Selection



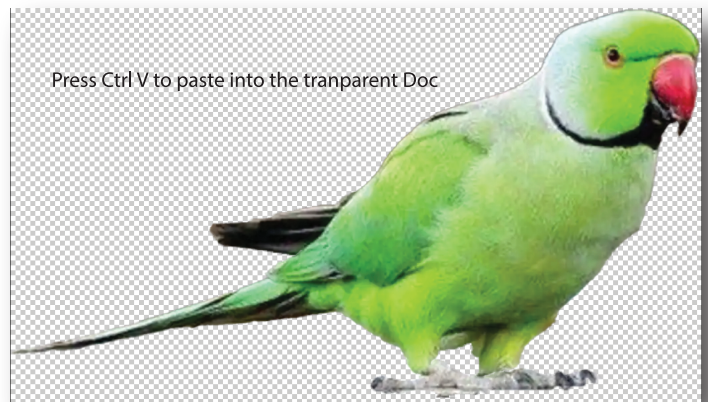
Choose Select>Inverse



Choose Clipboard, Transparent & Name the Doc

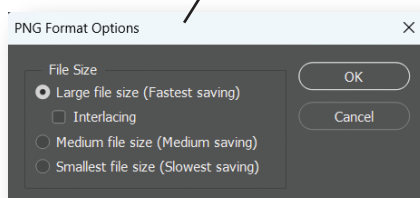
3. Open Photoshop and choose File>New. In the new dialogue box choose Clipboard for the size, name the document and Transparent for the Background Contents. Then click Create.

4. In the new checked document, press Ctrl V to paste in the selection.

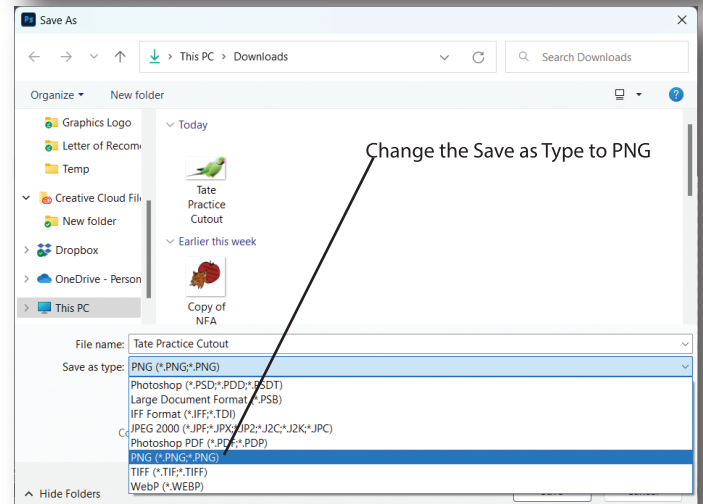


Press Ctrl V to paste into the transparent Doc

5. Save the image by choosing File>Save As. The document should already have a name but Save as Type needs to be changed to .png. In the new dialogue box that appears, simply click ok.



Click OK on the new dialogue box



Change the Save as Type to PNG
